**Al Pearce (1933)**

**Al Pearce & His Gang** (*Dole Pineapple / CBS Network*)

In 1928, Al Pearce got his start on the "Happy-Go-Lucky" program at KFRC Radio in San Francisco. By 1937, he was on CBS, sponsored by Ford in "Watch the Fun Go By." In 1937. During that run, Artie Auerbach joined the show as "Mr. Kitzel," until about 1946 when Auerbach landed on Jack Benny's show. Later, Pearce switched to the NBC Network but then back to CBS, when he was sponsored by Dole Pineapple. That lasted until 1940. Camel cigarets was his sponsor next for the CBS series which lasted until 1942.

His catch phrase was "Nobody home, I hope, I hope, I hope."

He died in 1961 at age 63. Only a handful of his shows have survived.

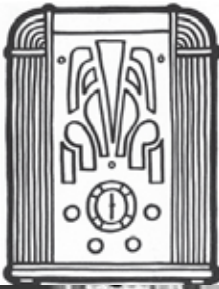
