



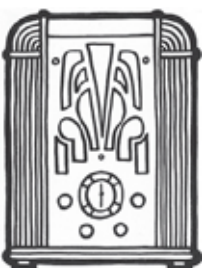

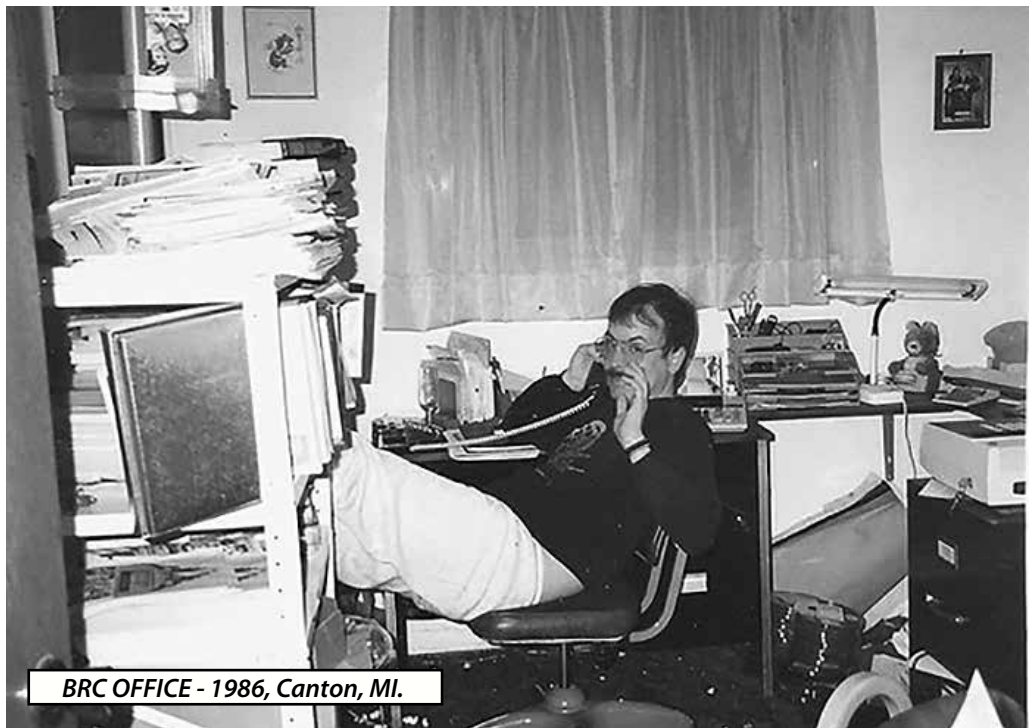

# Bob's Message Aug-Sept 2021

I started in radio as a teenager and have learned a lot along the way!

Everything in the universe has a beginning and end. Certainly "golden" radio as some knew it saw its end (as today's radio fans know it) in 1962. A lot of people knew it was something good because there was more than one attempt to bring radio back, especially with Himan Brown's efforts with the CBS Radio Mystery Theater.

The hobby of keeping the old shows preserved actually began around the time the golden age ended. There was also a silver age loaded with great DJ's, news and sports commentators. There's also an underground group of collectors of sports broadcasts. Those recordings, however, are largely copyright protected by their respective teams and organizations such as Major League Baseball.

For this month's offerings, it's more of the later episodes of *Yours Truly*, *Johnny Dollar* who shared with *Suspense* being the last "gasp" of radio drama. This, along with lots of shows that weren't available in digital format previously.

The photo of yours truly is from the mid 1980s – our office in Canton, Michigan, where we were when we *FIRST* launched the radio show on *Yesterday USA Superstation*. Several things happened at that time: We formed a buying group, wrote a book as well as started a local Detroit version of what would be called *Radio Vault* (my spin on Detroit radio re-broadcasts that were happening in the 1970s). My show took a hiatus for several years, but was brought back a few years ago.

Also in the 1980s, long time Detroit area collector, **Gene Bradford** (who passed several years ago) would circulate one of the first *Suspense* collections *IN DATED ORDER* on reel to reel tapes. Bradford wanted me to spearhead a Detroit area Old-Time Radio Convention, but there just wasn't time in my life, and **Bob Burchett** was already doing a spectacular job in Cincinnati. It simply wasn't practical in my life to re-invent the convention wheel in the 1980s. At that time, **Jay Hickerson** was on the cutting edge of conventions with the *Friends of OTR* events in Newark. So I just kept doing what I do: Promoting, Preserving and Restoring OTR to present day listeners.

In past catalogs, I have listed by name several people who are on a similar journey with me. I wouldn't be doing this without them. I also definitely wouldn't be doing it without several friends in *PRESENT DAY RADIO* who have continued to keep things interesting and continue to give me work! Everyone is important!

Thanks as always for your support, and check out the current weekly OTR radio show which airs live on **WHFR** streamed everywhere on [whfr.fm](http://whfr.fm) (89.3 FM in our area) currently Tuesdays 10AM-12Noon ET. Check their website for any updates.

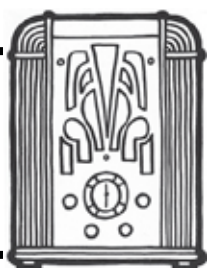
