This year, the radio station that keeps me the most busy (WHFR-FM) is celebrating 40 years of existing on the FM band in the Detroit area (and streaming everywhere as well).

In 1985 when the station was launched, I had already written my Technical Guide to Collecting Old-Time Radio book (which sold out of 1,000 copies that year). In 1984, for my writing, The Friends of Old Time Radio had already presented me with The Allen Rockford Award at their annual convention in New Jersey. I was already well on my way to what would become my profession and career doing something that started out as a hobby.



By then, I had already known two of my oldest friends in old-time radio for 10 years! We will save the details for later, but their names can be found on the list of "thanks" on the back page.

With this mailing we've offered much more of what has remained popular again, continuing with an emphasis on highest quality. Today, with the focus on digital formats (including standard CD), there is a level of consistant quality control that was never possible in the analog (cassette and reel to reel) days. My two books were efforts to make people more aware of what must be done to achieve some semblence of quality and preservation with the limitations we had at that time. I was inspired by the late **Chuck Seeley** (of Buffalo Old Time Radio Club fame) who had a similar publication but didn't offer as much depth. Like everything I try to do in life, I tried to take it to a new level and re-invent what I did for old-time radio. I'm not sure if I always succeed. With the writing and the follow-up edition in 1986, I may have made a dent.

Today, it's a different story. I have a background of audio processing with hardware tools, but we can do so much more with software now. The bottom line philosophy, however, has always been to *LISTEN* to what we're doing. As we age, however, our hearing does change. To compensate, we also have *VISUAL* tools now readily available with software. That includes things like waveform and spectrum displays and spectrum analyzers/viewers. We no longer have tapes heads, pinch rollers and capstans to clean and demagnetize. I do spend a lot of time looking at waveforms now and listening on high end headphones. Thanks for your support!
