Some 45 years ago, we started as just as an idea...

How could a middle class teenager keep up with his new-found hobby of collecting old-time radio programs?

The answer was simple: Start a business that markets the programs and makes them more affordable than what was then available, yet without sacrificing quality. It started as Bob's Recording Collection which was quickly shortened to BRC. His father, a Detroit area bank vice president, helped with all the details in the earliest years. We published an old-time radio newsletter, arbitrarily called "News & Reviews" which led to an association with one of our earliest customers, Bob Burchett. Burchett, a graphic artist of Cincinnati, Ohio gave us our image. Since then, we've relentlessly given everything else the polish it deserved... The rest is history.
