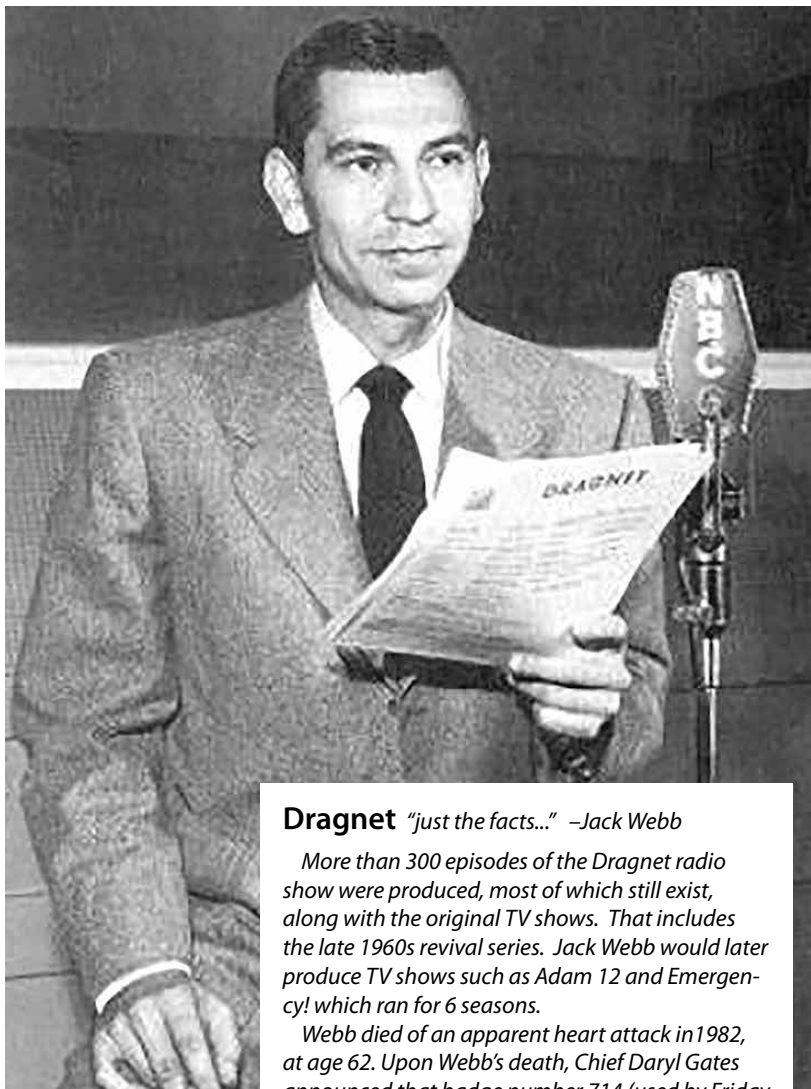


In today's real world, ordinarily with a standard audio CD, you couldn't tell specifically **WHAT** is playing **WHILE** it's playing. With our product, **YOU CAN** in most automobile players and some home media players! When loading a CD, the **SERIES** title will be displayed along with our catalog number. Next, as the playing begins, the broadcast date and episode title will be displayed. When you advance to the second show, the display will update to the second show. If there are more than 2 titles (such as on on Mixed Bag section) each show is indexed to display its own information. Each segment is limited as to the number of characters, however, occasionally when space is available (such as on the Suspense series) featured actors, guests, networks, etc. are shown as well all while the CD is playing). If you have older equipment, this information, however, is ignored. As far as old-time radio is concerned, this feature is somewhat exclusive to our CDs.

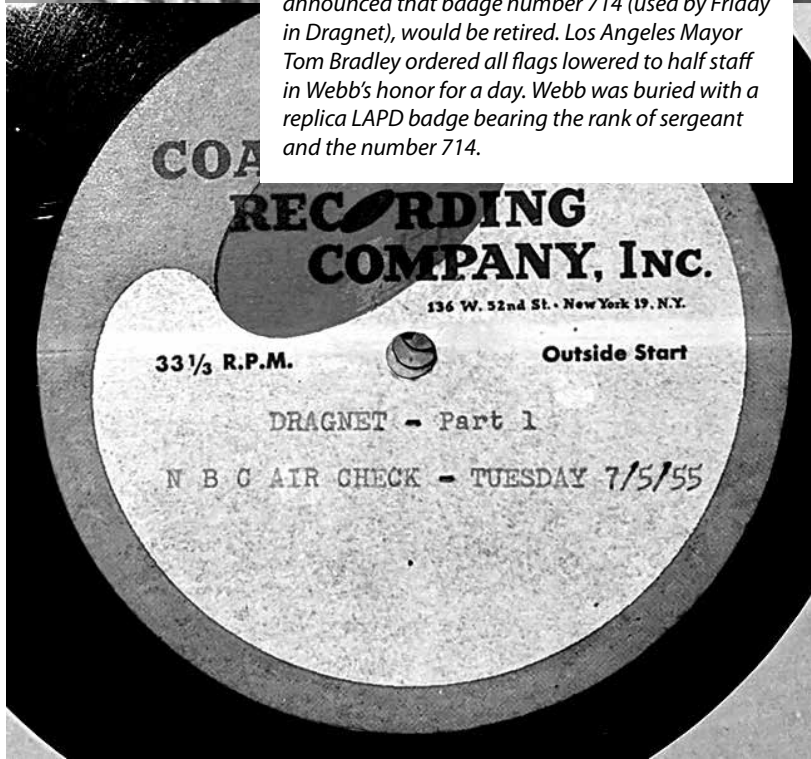

Dragnet "just the facts..." -Jack Webb

More than 300 episodes of the Dragnet radio show were produced, most of which still exist, along with the original TV shows. That includes the late 1960s revival series. Jack Webb would later produce TV shows such as Adam 12 and Emergency! which ran for 6 seasons.

Webb died of an apparent heart attack in 1982, at age 62. Upon Webb's death, Chief Daryl Gates announced that badge number 714 (used by Friday in Dragnet), would be retired. Los Angeles Mayor Tom Bradley ordered all flags lowered to half staff in Webb's honor for a day. Webb was buried with a replica LAPD badge bearing the rank of sergeant and the number 714.

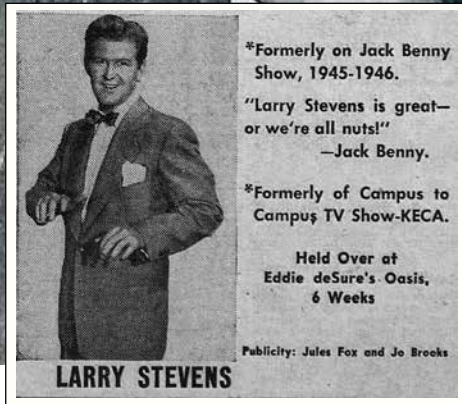

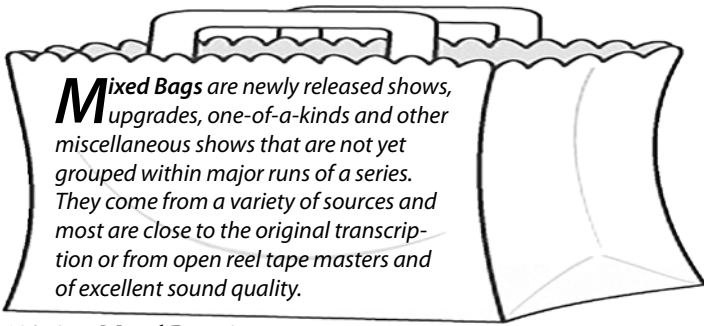
