Message from Bob...

Welcome to our latest offerings!

As we begin to wind down the year, it has truly been an interesting time. So far this year, we have added nearly 300 hours of programming to the digital CD library and the majority of the material has been of excellent sound quality. Many of the shows have never been available before. Some are upgrades. This also doesn't include the lower priority items that have been added to the archive waiting for the mastering process.

In the earlier years, dealers and collectors would provide sound quality ratings. Today, generally, it's not necessary. Back then, if you had a copy of a copy of a copy, in the reel to reel and cassette years, it wouldn't sound as good as lower generation copy. We began focusing in on the better quality material because in those years, we didn't have the computer-based tools we have today to improve the sound. We did have audio boxes that made some improvement, but not like we have today. Some of the best quality, however, could be obtained for a price.

One of the first widely known sources that we depended on was Dave Goldin's **Radio Yesteryear**. They typically charged \$12 an hour, but you would be assured of getting the best available sound on tape (or from his Radiola Records division). Today, collectors have been known to pay up to \$800 for a single rare show in electrical transcription (16" disc) format.

No individual can afford \$800 a show or even \$100 a show. The

emergence of Buying Groups in the 1970s, however, pioneered by among others, collector **Ron Barnett** in the Washington D.C. area, brought hundreds of better quality shows into circulation. By the end of the decade, using the same methods, **Joe Webb** and I had brought the first **Johnny Dollar** 5-partner shows with **Bob Bailey** into general circulation. During the 1980s, I formed **Collector's Alliance** with about a dozen esteemed collectors and dealers, and we purchased entire catalogs from

esteemed suppliers with great sound. Some of those suppliers (and our members) are no longer around, but those very recordings formed the start of our digital library of today.

As I have said before, old-time radio today is much larger niche than it has ever been only thanks to the dedication of many people whom I mention in our catalogs. As a broadcast engineer, my job today is to do what I can to get the shows ready for re-broadcast as well as distribution. Marketing is also key to what I do. What good is it to have hundreds of shows in broadcast quality fidelity if no one knows you have them?
