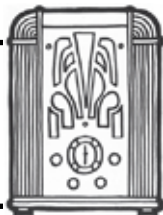

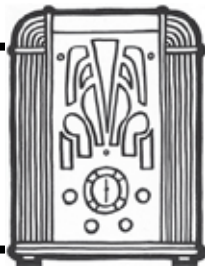

Meantime, if you're ordering from older catalogs or mailers, please don't order at the old rates.
